Since 2008, he has been also Professor with the Technical University of Berlin. He has authored or coauthored more than 350 publications and conference contributions. His present research interests include MMIC design with an emphasis on GaN power amplifiers, mm-wave integrated circuits and packaging, and electromagnetic simulation.
