## Mohammad Madihian

*In Recognition of a Distinguished Record of Service to the MTT Society and the Microwave Profession over a Sustained Period of Time*

Mohammad Madihian (LF'20) received the PhD in electronic engineering in 1983, and has been an MTT-S member since 1984.

He received the 1988 IEEE Microwave Prize for his work "GaAs-monolithic IC's for X-band PLL stabilized local source" which appeared in the IEEE Trans. MTT in June 1986. This work was carried out during 1984-1985 when he was still a "trainee" at NEC and not permitted to present the work at an international symposium himself.

Mohammad has received numerous R&D Achievement Awards and IEEE Certificates of Recognition including the 1998 IEEE Fellow Award.

He was the 2010 Secretary and has served on several Committees including Operation; Publication; Budget; TCC/TCFDC; Meeting & Symposia; and MGA.
