


Microwave Career Award

James Lin is Professor Emeritus at University of Illinois Chicago, where he served as department chair, engineering-college laboratory and project director, and as ECE and physiology professor. A Fellow of AAAS, AIMBE, URSI, and IEEE Life Fellow, recognized as ScholarGPS Highly Ranked Scholar and Elsevier Top Worldwide Scientists for Career Impact, received IEEE Transactions Prize Paper Award, Bioelectromagnetics Society's d'Arsonval Medal (also Editor-in-Chief), and served on U.S. President's National Medal of Science Committee. He edited 11, authored 4 books, and published 450 journal papers and book chapters. He obtained BS, MS and PhD in electrical engineering from University of Washington.
